



Day 1 Keynote

Thursday, 26th October, 2023 9.00 a.m. EAT

Africa's Talking and Products Introduction

Speaker: CEO, Paul Wamalwa, and AT Product Teams Representatives This session mainly served as an introduction to the Africa's Talking company. Why DevOps and DevOps Hackathon

In a research conducted by SrongDM DevOps Statistics, 99% of respondents said DevOps has had a positive impact on their organization. 78% had to learn a new skill. 48% of respondents said it helped them get a raise. 61% said it helped them produce higher-quality deliverables. In this session, the speaker focused on the positive impact and higher-quality deliverables, so why DevOps, as the stats say, we all need DevOps. He broke this into two: DevOps in terms of delivering and in terms of Monitoring. As a recruiter, attendees got insights into what to look for in some individuals and as an interviewer, they got insights into what tool or tools to look for in a given skillset in a candidate.

Privacy Preserving Digital Identity for Africans - The Story of Kweli and Building Practical Software for Agriculture

The speaker had two sessions. The first session featured Antugrow, cloud software developed by Vibranium ID to easen operations of Farmer Agricultural Cooperatives by digitizing record keeping via on-demand analytics and instant communication with Farmers. The second session was on Kweli, a software that encompasses open standards and open-source software that developers can use to build applications that support free trade in Africa. Kweli uses Blockchain Identity and champions consent driven verification for people and businesses. The session illustrated the architecture used, possible use cases, and how developers can contribute to Kweli.

From Cells to Statistics: An Accessible **Guide to Genomic Data Science**

This session took the form of a workshop that explored the field of genomic data science. Through hands-on exploration of concepts in cell biology, molecular genetics, and computational approaches like machine learning, attendees discovered how this innovative discipline combines biology and computer science to tackle major healthcare challenges. They learnt about DNA, the code of life, then saw how it can be digitized and analyzed at massive scales. Through a focus on cancer genomics, they were shown how genomic data science approaches are illuminating the factors that influence disease and improving our ability to study variation across huge patient populations. By the end of the session, they had an engaging introduction to this frontier where big data meets biology, and got a glimpse of its potential to transform medicine and human health.


